**CATEGORIES:**

*(Subject of entry must be within Greater Hume Shire Council area and should capture the spirit of our unique area and in addition must be accepted by the judges as pertaining to the section theme.)*

- Best Photo of Table Top Mountain/Yambla Range
- Best Photo of an Event/Show/Exhibition/Fair/Fete within Greater Hume Shire
- Best Photo of an Attraction/Icon within Greater Hume Shire
- Best Photo of a Landscape (could be environmental or agricultural) within Greater Hume Shire

**PHOTOGRAPHIC GUIDELINES:**

- Full Colour, preferable CMYK but RGB accepted.
- Must be 300 dpi (high resolution) at finish size.
- Presented unframed (electronic copies will also be required).
- Maximum of 15 photographs per person to be entered.
- Photos should be no more than 3 years old.
- Where possible but not compulsory photos should show people interacting.
- Key elements of a good image are: lighting, environment/location, colour, talent, emotional appeal, engaging subject matter, spontaneity, composition and scale.
- The images should be inspiring, engaging, motivational, inviting and sell the dream of visiting Greater Hume Shire as well as showing a sense of reality.

1. The Greater Hume Shire Photography Competition 2009 is open to all.
2. Participation in this competition is free.
3. Subject of entry must be within Greater Hume Shire Council area and should capture the spirit of our unique area and in addition must be accepted by the judges as pertaining to the section theme.
4. It is a condition of entry that all entries may be used unconditionally in any promotional material produced by Greater Hume Shire Council. It should also be noted that some of the photographs submitted may never be used, however they will be part of a digital library which is held by Greater Hume Shire Council.
5. To comply with privacy legislation, if you submit a photograph of an adult who is identifiable, then you must obtain their written consent by completing Greater Hume Shire Council's photograph consent form, which is attached. If you submit a photograph of a child who is identifiable, you must obtain the written consent of the child's parent or guardian using Greater Hume Shire Council's photograph consent form, which is attached. Entries received without a completed consent forms (if required) will not be accepted.
6. Any entries submitted by persons under the age of eighteen (18) years must also be signed by the parent/guardian of the child/ren giving permission for that child/ren to enter this competition.
7. Entries will be judged by representatives of Greater Hume Shire Council, a community member and Tourism NSW. Judging will take place in January 2010. Winners will be announced at Greater Hume Shire Council's Australia Day Celebrations. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. Greater Hume Shire Council accepts no responsibility for lost, late or incomplete entries.
9. Copyright of any work submitted remains with the photographer. By submitting the work, the photographer gives Greater Hume Shire Council permission to reproduce, communicate and to display the work to the public. Greater Hume Shire Council may also publish the work in any publication. The purpose of such reproduction, communication, public display or publication is for educational, resource or publicity purposes. Greater Hume Shire Council reserves the right to edit or crop images for the purposes of promotion and publicity on the internet, shire events and other media material forms.

The photographer is solely responsible for ensuring that any photograph submitted to the Greater Hume Shire Council's Photograph Competition does not infringe on any third party's intellectual property rights or the rights of privacy or publicity of any third party. This includes text, data, photographs, graphics or any other materials. Greater Hume Shire Council accepts no liability whatsoever for any breaches of these conditions of entry.
11. All entries will be non returnable.
12. If there are any discrepancies as to the correct ownership of the entry, the judges reserve the right to eliminate the photograph from the competition.
