## ROAD FUNDING IN SUPPORT OF DROUGHT RELIEF

Greater Hume Council will be receiving much needed funds to support the increased movement of stock, feed and water as part of the drought relief package from NSW Government.

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin said the NSW Government has been working in partnership with Local Government NSW to evaluate submissions received by councils across the state.

“Eligible councils can apply for up to \$300,000 to help with road maintenance and improvements to accommodate increased freight movements,” Mr Aplin said.

The NSW Government has committed to providing \$285,950 to Greater Hume Council to improve Culcairn-Walbundrie Road.

Mr Aplin said the Drought Relief Heavy Vehicle Access Program was announced on 21 October 2018 and offers an additional \$15 million toward the cost of maintenance and minor improvement work on council roads and roadsides.

“These improvements will contribute to heavy vehicle access, in support of the drought relief task,” Mr Aplin said.

“The changes will support farmers impacted by the drought by improving heavy vehicle access on local roads, which has increased as a result of the drought conditions.”

Mr Aplin said in January 2019, 23 submissions from 20 different councils across NSW were approved for funding under round one of the program. This second round of evaluations will see an additional 18 submissions from 12 councils approved.

“All project submissions were assessed against the program criteria and are recommended for funding, bringing the total value of work committed to about \$10 million,” Mr Aplin said.

“Submissions will continue to be assessed on a regular basis until the \$15 million allocation is exhausted. The next evaluation is planned for March 2019.”

In July last year, the Liberals and Nationals in government announced a \$500 million Emergency Drought Relief Package, taking the NSW Liberals & Nationals total drought support to more than \$1 billion.






**Cash Fund Performance Against RBA Cash Rate**




**30 Day Term Deposit Performance Against BBSW Index**









**Cash Fund Performance Against RBA Cash Rate**



You may be aware of the enormous blackberry burden in the Lankeys Creek area, if not you should travel through the area and note the extent of this problem.

It is generally within pine plantation areas. This needs to be addressed as it has escalated over the past few years with little apparent control measures put in place. The weed problem encroaches on neighbouring properties, infests waterways, National Parks, Shire land. It overtakes native plant species and provides shelter for feral animals as well as increasing workload and chemical use for land holders in the area.

This problem needs to be addressed for the future of this area. The Council must insist that plantation owners control the weeds they have been ignoring for too long. I have advised residents to contact you regarding this matter as well.
