Please read and complete the **Herd Health Status Declaration V1 – 02.05.18**. No Entry will not be accepted without this document (Entries will only be accepted from herds which are J-BAS 6 or higher).

#### Showground Gate Entry Fee: \$15.00 per vehicle

- 1. The age of all cattle is to be calculated up to 1<sup>st</sup> March, e.g. 20 months and under 24 months before 1<sup>st</sup> March.
- 2. CATTLE ARE TO BE ON SHOWGROUND BY 8.00am TO ALLOW FOR NLIS RECORDING.
- 3. Cattle judging to commence at 10.00am on Sunday 24th March 2019.
- 4. Cows over 3 years of age must be in calf or have calf at foot.
- 5. Any calf that is exhibited with mother, cannot be exhibited in a separate class
- 6. All exhibits at all times to be provided with strong halters and nose clips.
- 7. All bulls must have a nose ring and at all times be led by a halter and nose lead.
- 8. All females must at all times be led by a nose clip and lead.
- 9. All exhibits must be securely tethered by an effective head stall in addition to a neck strap or rope.
- 10. If in the opinion of the Chief Steward, any exhibit is deemed to be dangerous, or not under proper control in the show ring, the owner of such exhibit shall immediately upon receiving notice to the effect, remove such exhibit from the Societies grounds.
- 11. All cattle exhibits must be paraded before the judges of the section.
- 12. All beef cattle exhibited at the Holbrook Annual Show must conform to the rules for "Pure Breed Cattle Classes" as at the 2019 RAS Show.
- 13. Paraders are to be correctly attired in Breed Society requirements.
- 14. No child under the age of 12 years of age is to lead an animal in the general classes.
- 15. All exhibitors, handlers and grooms must sign an Indemnity Form and be issued with a wrist band. **This band is to be worn at all times.** For persons under the age of 18 years the Indemnity Form is to be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- 16. The committee reserve the right to alter the program to meet emerging circumstances.

#### **CATTLE CLASSES**

Cattle will be in two sections for judging –

A – British Breeds (Angus, Hereford, Murray Grey etc) and

**B** – European Breeds (Limousin, Charolais etc.)

Therefore an 8 to 12 month Angus Bull would fit in Class 1A

- 1. Bull 8 months and under 12 months (any breed)
- 2. Bull -12 months and under 16 months (any breed)
- 3. Bull -16 months and under 20 months (any breed)

#### Champion Junior Bull & Reserve Champion Junior Bull

- 4. Bull 20 months and under 24 months (any breed)
- 5. Bull 24 months and over (any breed)

#### **Champion Senior Bull & Reserve Champion Senior Bull**

#### **Grand Champion Bull**

- 6. Heifer 8 months and under 12 months (any breed)
- 7. Heifer 12 months and under 16 months (any breed)
- 8. Heifer 16 months and under 20 months (any breed)

#### **Champion Junior Heifer & Reserve Champion Junior Heifer**

- 9. Heifer 20 months and under 24 months (any breed)
- 10. Heifer/Cow 24 months and over (any breed)

# **Champion Senior Female & Reserve Champion Senior Female**

### **Grand Champion Female**

- 11. Pair of animals bred by exhibitor (both sexes to be represented)
- 12. Pair of Bulls under 24 months
- 13. Pair of Heifers under 24 months
- 14. LED STEER any age.
