

# Pacific Island workers COVID-19 information



- Keep 1.5m between you and other people.
- If you are living with other people and sharing facilities, keep 1.5m distance. If it is not possible to physically distance, please wear a mask.
- Wash your hands as many times as possible often and use hand sanitiser when you are out.
- Download the Service NSW app to your smartphone. Scan the QR check-in code using this app every time you go to a venue. This is how you will know if you are at risk of COVID-19.
- If you are feeling sick, do not go to work. Call your boss and tell them if you are sick.
- Get tested straight away for COVID-19 and self-isolate until you get a negative test result. Find a COVID-19 testing clinic near you by visiting [nsw.gov.au](https://nsw.gov.au)
- A COVID-19 test is free for everyone.
- If you get a bus to work, you must wear a mask.
- You can get a free third (3) COVID-19 vaccine, if you are aged 18+ and it has been 6 months since you received your second (2) dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.
