## **REASON FOR REPORT**

To present a report to Council for determination following a Council Workshop held on Monday 16 April 2018 to consider applications received from Community Organisations and Council initiated applications under the Stronger Country Communities Fund (SCCF) Round 2.

Strategy Engage the community to develop Recreation Plans describing accessible and age friendly public facilities in our spaces and places – parks, playgrounds and reserves, public toilets, sporting fields, swimming pools, public halls

Councillors will recall that at the March meeting of Council the timeline outlined in Table 1 was adopted for Round 2 of the SCCF.

At the closure of Expression of Interest phase 38 applications were received seeking funding totalling \$5,460,844.65. Advice was received from the NSW Office of Regional Development that Council has been allocated \$1,598,000.

#### STRONGER COUNTRY COMMUNITIES FUND - ROUND 2 [CONT'D]

A Councillor Workshop was held on Monday, 16 April 2018 to consider the merits of the applications received and to develop a priority for submission to the Stronger Country Communities Fund Assessment Team for consideration.

Information distributed by the Office of Regional Development encouraged Councils to make multiple applications with a combined total value that exceeds their funding allocation.

Table 2 on Page 3 outlines details the projects recommended to be put forward in priority order.

As can be seen from Table 2 it is proposed that Council submit 15 projects totalling \$2,141,234.82 when only \$1,598,000 is available to Council under the Stronger Country Communities Fund. Therefore it is emphasised that not all projects put forward will be funded through the program.

## **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

It is not anticipated that Council will make any direct unbudgeted financial contributions to nominated projects therefore the program should not have an impact on Council's budgetary process. It should be noted however that Council will have the responsibility to ensure the Community Groups can complete the projects within the allocated funding and acquit the funding allocations in due course.

## CONCLUSION

Round 2 of the SCCF is a significant funding allocation from the NSW Government and provides the opportunity to fund a number of sporting and community projects that would not be possible otherwise.

The projects recommended to be put forward will make a real difference in the communities in which they will be undertaken.
