### **CADDY LINERS**

Use only council approved compostable liners in your kitchen caddy. Other plastic bags even if they are labeled as biodegradable or compostable can't be accepted.

Every year, you will receive a year's supply of compostable liners. If you run out of liners early or don't want to use them you can put your food scraps and garden waste straight into your kitchen caddy and green lidded organics bin. Alternatively you can pick up small rolls from your local council free of charge to see you through until the re-delivery.

### KITCHEN CADDY

Kitchen caddies (bench top 'mini-bins') are available to all households and will be delivered to residents prior to the 3 bin rollout. These are a clean and easy way to collect your fruit and vegetable scraps, fish, meat, bones, coffee grinds & tea leaves. This is your daily organic material which is in your home.

\*Kitchen Caddy shown in the image above may be different to the caddy you recieve at home.

We understand that this may not suit everyone's needs, therefore we have a range of options available to residents, such as additional recycling bins. Contact your local council to discuss the costs and options available to you.

# 3 BIN SYSTEM **FAQS**

### WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?

According to waste audits conducted in your region in 2021, food and garden waste accounts for 51% of the waste materials in an average household red lidded general waste bin. This fills up our local landfills and wastes a valuable resource.

Methane is produced when food and garden materials are buried underground and break down without oxygen. By using your new green lidded bin for all your food and garden waste, your waste will be turned into compost for our farms, parks and gardens.

Some residents are moving from 1 bin or no kerbside collections to a 3 bin service. We understand its a big change for households and the Halve Waste team is working across your communities to help everyone understand the changes.

### GREAT TIPS TO USING YOUR **NEW 3 BIN SYSTEM**

- To view the collection calendar for the yellow, red, or green lidded organics bin visit Halve Waste, or your local council's website.
- Place one of the supplied compostable liners inside your kitchen caddy.
- Keep your kitchen caddy somewhere handy like on the kitchen bench, under the sink or in the fridge (if you have space).
- Place all food scraps from meal preparation, plate scrapings and expired foods into your caddy - remember to keep out food packaging.
- When the liner is full, or every couple of days, simply place it straight into your green lidded bin, along with your garden waste.
- Have a separate container for your recycling.
- Put your green lidded bin out for collection weekly.
- You can also use the caddy without liners.
