

Residents/Landowners of Greater Hume Council wishing to undertake Roadside Grazing adjacent to their property are required to obtain consent from Council. If consent is granted the letter of consent needs to be forwarded to Murray Local Land Services (LLS) for the issuing of a permit.

Grazing in front of neighbouring properties (Immediate Neighbours Only) is only permitted with the written consent from the neighbouring property owner/s. Neighbouring Property Owner/s must complete and sign this form (The Roadside Grazing Neighbouring Property Owner/s Consent Form). This form must be submitted with the Roadside Grazing Consent Application.

Grazing within High Conservation Areas is not allowed.

Note Council reserves the right to revoke this consent at any time if circumstances such as complaints received or roadworks are planned.
